Principal Update: Claire Mognaga

- Excited about Holiday boutique – thanked Teagin. She will be there to help in anyway we need
- December newsletter went out today
  - DPIE enrollment has done really well for winter quarter – 104 students currently enrolled. More than we have ever had.
  - Tree lighting on December 7<sup>th</sup> at Dublin High – lots of good things happening that night and open to all
  - Math Kangaroo is coming to our site – it started in Australia. Students can register, join and join online and meet with other families on line that are interested in math. Do math competitions on their own. But yearly there is an annual competition that is held. Fred is now going to be a private site. We are now on their map. Competition id in March.
