■ Budget Overview and Voting

37% of our total budget goes towards students grants. 350\$ is allocated per each teacher for school year. 28% goes towards events, 7% for PFC operations, 6% staff recognitions, 2000\$ for facilities, 12% for specific events for students, 1000\$ for PBIS. Red tickets are issued to students that follow rules and students can use these red tickets to purchase. 50 tickets can buy a popsicle party, 150 can buy a door dash lunch for the student and a teacher of their choosing and so on. 41059\$ is the total budget for 2024-25 school year. 80% of it comes from donati9ons collected at the beginning of the school year. 650\$ is allocated for trunk or treat. Left over money is sitting in the money market and is earning 200\$ per month. Move to approve the budget, everyone approved.

Open Discussion (All Present)

District has cut 5 million dollars in funding to all the schools and as a result many software programs were cut. Accelerated reader software has been cut off just before the summer break and teachers did not have time to prepare accordingly. 3500\$ is requested by Mr Britten to purchase accelerated reading licenses. Camille motioned to approve, and Alyssa seconded. Everyone present voted in favor.
