Boosterthon raised a total of 39000\$. 8000\$ corporate matches are still pending. We have started character awards in the assembly. One award per class. The character trait for September was Respect and the character trait for October is responsibility. Home coming parade is scheduled for October 18 and everyone is welcome to participate. - **Math Kangaroo**

- **Dublin Education Alliance**

Shazia, Seema and Anita came from DEA to talk to PFC members. The ask is to educate parents and spread the word about budget cuts. Lat year there was a deficit of 4.4 million in funds for Dublin school district and this school year this deficit has gone up to 5.5. million. Because of this deficit there was a cut in staffing for special projects teachers. No summer school for middle school kids, no access to Zello app. This app helps kids find a college path. The goal is to raise 500k in funds this year. The difference between DPIE and DEA is that DPIE sells services and DEA doesn't. DEA will not be relying just on parent donations, they will be reaching out for corporate donations as well.
