Anticipate state mid year budget to be low. Try to keep Assistant Principles and Counselors for elementary. Mid shift custodians – bargain for furlough days for staff. Considering a mural in the library. Seek support from PFC to fund.

President Update:

Movie Nighty was huge success with over 200 attending. PFC netted \$200 from concession sales. Game Night attendance was also more than anticipated. Giri is excited to host once again next year. Not all age groups were supported. Not enough volunteers. Parents want to pitch in for snacks next time. Solicite student council or high school volunteers to run games for next time. Ice Cream Fridays to return in January. Motion to vote Teagin Bland in an Event Coordinator at 7:23PM. Seconded by Alyssa Klozer. All voted in favor. Remaining events: January – Movie Night; February – Donuts with Grownups; March – Pi Night; April – Glow Dance; May – Teacher Appreciation Week; Monthly Staff Cart. Plug for Social Media Coordinator.

Fundraising Update:

\$1,160 from dinouts so far for the year. Future dinouts to be Mr. Softee and Pizza My Heart. See's Candies fundraiser ended 12/6. Made \$577. Holiday Boutique to include hot cocoa bar, letter writing, crafts. 12 vendors. Mrs. Brown suggested having Mrs. Sevilla back to read stories. Bonnie asked about how we're doing in fundraising. We've made a bit less, but still doing well. Bonnie offered to help with cleanup at boutique. Teachers going to help facilitate in classrooms for Art to Remember. Proceeds to go toward mural in library? Book vending machine was considered to hefty of an investment. Mrs. Brown suggested May Giang for the mural artist. Going to reach out to connect. Art needs to be returned by 2/19. Bonnie suggested she prefers social posts continue to be made by individuals rather than general page author.

Treasurer Update:

Executed 32% of budget so far. Raised \$25,737. Teacher reimbursement is at 16% of budget. Reminder that Facilitron has increased rates to keep hours to minimum.
Use invoice and check; no credit card payments. Holly to reimburse expenses within 30 days after event. Large purchases can use a credit card or check or Amazon account.
