- EOY Budget Review

We have a budget of 29000\$ this year. Dine outs are very successful. 2581.66\$ from dine outs. Roll over 4000\$ to teachers and staff. 3300 out of 11000\$ budget spent on events. This is because of parent donations. We have a few events left to go. The estimation is 5000\$. We spent a lot more on student support 8175\$ that includes PBIS rewards and educational programs. So far we have spent around 17000\$. School has funds which can be used for student development programs. General funds from site allocation can be used to fund these programs. These are also used to buy furniture, paper, school supplies etc. Request from school to fund 5th grade science camp 2000\$. This year science camp had more students and the buses we usually rent weren't enough. So they had to get some vans. School usually funds science camps apart from parent donations. Parents paid 450\$. For us to keep the science camp budget reasonable, school is asking 2000\$ from PFC budget. Since we are under budget for events, we can support 4th grade parents in fund raising. We can donate this year and then every year, we can decide based on need. Holly motioned to donate 2000\$ to 5th grade science camp this year and Camille seconded. Everyone voted in favor.
