- **Welcome/Introductions (All Present)**

- **Principal Update: Matt Britten**

We have a couple of things, first, we are excited as we are named official purple star school-meaning we work closely with military families to acclimate quickly and let them register even before they move. There are only 75 purple star schools in the state. Walk through the American resolution has been very successful. Right now, we have very difficult contract negotiations going on and there could be a potential strike starting as early as next week. Teagin asked if everyone decides to walk out is Mr. Britten left by himself. Principals are considered admin staff so they will come in along with other officials, and we may have guest teachers. Camille asked if we need adults to be on campus if families decide to send their kids. We know from strikes from previous districts, roughly 10% students have showed up and we will have enough adults to supervise them. Vindhya asked will we know beforehand if it is going to happen and a walk out happens, and parents are notified. We will know by tomorrow. The last part of bargaining is called fact finding, they try to have a moderator's proposal which is being released tomorrow. If the teachers do not accept, the teachers can go on strike, and they will give 48-hour notice. Students will go to MPR attendance is taken and students will be divided and sent to respective classes and guest teachers teach them. Sindhu asked what the recommendation for the parents in such scenarios is. Teachers have a demand that they are asking and it is the parents' choice to decide for yourself. DTA is asking for parent volunteers and donations for the teachers at picket line. This is considered excused absence. Suchitra asked if it effects attendance. If the students are not comfortable you can inform the same to the attendance line and it is considered excused leave. Camille asked how long it could take to reach an agreement. 2 years back when similar thing happened, they had an emergency session and reached an agreement. There is no way of knowing how long it lasts, the expectation is 1 day as Thursday and Friday are already holidays, it could go 3 days. SF united went on strike last week and they went on a strike for a whole week. It is not a Dublin issue; it's the state issue. California does not fund properly so it has been a consistent issue. If anyone has any questions, they can reach out to Mr. Britten.
