We have spring break coming up and after spring break till the end of the year, everyday there is something like the science wizard assembly, PFC is sponsoring. 1st grade is going on a field trip during their assembly. We have a bench dedication, donated by the stager family, as a memory for one of the teachers who used to teach at Fred and Dublin high. Lots of field trips coming up. Post strike things are going well. PFC had music, balloons, treats once the teachers are break from school. Some schools did not have coming back together like that. Student wise 650 students. 30 less than this year as Shamrock hill is opening. We have 30 students inter district transfer to Fred who may or may not end up at Shamrock. At Fred every year we undercount students. Good news is we have a new TK class next year. We are still down a 4th grade class. 4th grade class is 4 now so next year 5th grade is going to be 4. We are projecting only 3 4th grade classes next year. part of new agreement is to have lower class sizes. District can pay overage to teachers if the class size is bigger. hard cap for classes is same for each grade and each year. We may still have the same number of classes we have this year. Mr. Britten is not returning next year, they have found a district internal candidate that will be announced at the board meeting on April 14. Assistance principal positions are eliminated this year, some will be converted to principals, some director positions are also eliminated, and they will be moved to school sights. Secondary assistant principals are not cut down, elementary are being cut. Our surrounding school districts elementaries do not have an assistant principal. Last day of work is June 12th. All the assistant principals have many years of experience and they are all good.

- Budget Report

11583.24 is the balance, 450 Cash for the book fair loaned, we will get back on Friday, no one submitted staff reimbursements this month. 220\$ in punch card sakes; pi night expenses not received. 5th grade promotions have 610 from future funds in addition to 650 set aside from the budget. Our staff is pawsome events wrapped up for the year. 855 is budgeted for OSIP from future fund donations we are over the budget. 223 out of 750 is left over from the teacher spirit wear fund, 855 is the future fund amount and we have additional amount in stripe. Surplus of 94.08 based on concession vs spend. Actual tab is showing a 637 spend. Actual does not reflect what we brought in, individual movie night tab shows the breakdown. Movie night budget for the year is 1000 we only spend 637\$. Sep 19 148.50\$ facilities fee, pizza 109.70\$ plus we have water.
