- **Guest Speaker: Tri Valley Air Quality Climate Alliance**

Ann Brown is school's outreach director. Mr Britten is the only principal that said yes, TV Aqua is a local organization that educates about air quality, we had 2 cycles of grants and that ended. Now we are all just volunteers, we have connected with Livermore to understand their initiatives for climate and air quality. The city of Dublin realized they couldn't do the outreach on their own, so they asked Livermore to do the outreach for them. I would help with the outreach for the schools. Now I work for tri valley conservancies, we have offered a 4th grade program. Starting with the schools that hosted TV aqua. We were here during pi night. The real power is to get a group together through schools so that the parents can feel part of school community and

work for climate improvement, the city of Dublin gave us permission, the QR code on the flyer would put you directly in the group, we have already created a group for panthers. Parents make an account and include their children to own the actions. The city is looking for new actions to drive down climate impacts around us. The challenge ends on May 15th and we will announce winners based on how much they saved. It is about taking action together. For the families that join and taken action, we have some swag like metal cups, bags etc, provided by the city of Dublin, we would like to reach out to staff, we are going to offer staff members that join a raffle for gift cards as an appreciation. I encourage everyone in PFC to join and lead by example. Talk about it to your kids and other parents, posting on social media is a good way to spread awareness. That is panthers for the planet challenge, we will present the school with a check on May 19th. City of Dublin has announced 1000\$ for all the schools that participate.
